



Managing a Drip Irrigation System in the Sonoran Desert

This class is designed to give an overview of the basic philosophies and techniques of managing a drip irrigation system in the Sonoran Desert. The presenters are local landscapers who earn their living installing and maintaining these types of systems.

Topics include:

- Overview of system elements, including back flow preventer, controller, electric valves and all fittings from piping to nozzles.
- Watering needs of desert adapted plants, turf and flowers.
- Hands on demonstration on how to set the controller for automatic operation.
- Trouble shooting and repair tips for the entire system



Upon completion the participants should have the skills they need to understand, program and maintain a simple irrigation system typically found on most homes in our desert. This is a free class with class size strictly limited to 20 people. We ask that you bring your own folding chairs, water etc. As this is an outdoor class so dress accordingly...class will be held rain or shine (we can move indoors if need be).
